### *IVBC Serving God in the Community*

In the late 70's, many community needs were met under the support and sponsorship of the Church's outreach and mission work. There were two such missions which have become permanent agencies and services. The *Young-At-Heart* program was sponsored by WMU (Women's Missionary Union) and coordinated by Myrna Janney. The program originated on March 3, 1976, and God is still using this program to meet needs and minister to many people. The *Lighthouse Learning Center* was the second mission which opened its doors in December of 1977 under the direction of Cathy Thompson.
