Actually, though, I didn't need either one of them to tell me the thermometer has not been keeping up with the calendar recently! I mean, come on, it's April already!

Still, cold mornings notwithstanding, the dogwoods and azaleas know it's spring, and they are bursting forth with the announcement. The flowers planted around the church building a few weeks ago add their own exclamation point to that statement.

So we have hope for warmer days and renewed life in nature, as our other dead-looking plants and flowers begin to bud and sprout. And our brown lawns are slowly winning their struggle to turn green again.
