Reflections . . . From Richard

Caring for your Pastor

I gleaned the following suggestions from an article published by Center for Congregational Health, which trains interim ministers (like me!). The comments originally came from a workshop in which 80 laypersons were asked how a congregation could care for their pastor.

Personal Needs -

- Affirm and express appreciation to the pastor on a regular basis
- Protect the pastor's time off
- Value the pastor's humanity as a positive trait
- Encourage exercise, rest and proper diet
- Help the pastor have a life outside the church (civic clubs, community organizations, etc.)
- Provide extended, sabbatical times away

Family Needs -

- Let family members be themselves, not extensions of the pastor or church
- Recognize the spouse on special occasions
- Allow the pastor time to celebrate family events—anniversaries, children's activities, birthdays
- Provide paid opportunities for family growth, such as retreats and conferences

Spiritual Needs -

- Pray for the pastor, 'without ceasing'
- Encourage the pastor to be involved in peer learning or spiritual growth support groups
- Give the pastor ample time for personal meditation and study
- Pay for and insist on continuing education events and opportunities

Church Needs -

- Recognize the evolving, changing nature of the church and community, and encourage the pastor in leading the church to adapt
- Partner with the pastor in discovering and implementing the church's vision and mission
- Recognize the pastor's call from God and respect his position and leadership
- Preserve the unity of the fellowship

So, I leave you—not with 'good-bye' - but with the German phrase *auf wiedersehen*, which means, 'until we meet again.'

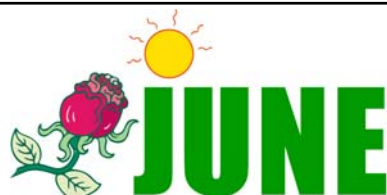
