From the Pastor

I'm sure there is more than one way for a pastor's family to get "pounded." You all have done it the right way! One month ago, you brought enough food to fill our pantry to overflowing. Andrea and Karis and I are so very grateful. As it stands, it will be a while before we buy a can of vegetables in the state of Florida. And in spite of our little girl's best efforts to go through them all, we still have plenty of diapers on hand.

Earlier this week, I stopped by the Clothes Closet here in Orange Park to meet some of the volunteers who devote so much time to serving people in our area. If you don't know it already, this ministry is a crucial one in our area. Island View and other area churches refer many people to the Clothes Closet for food, clothing, and rent assistance, etc.

Only three years ago, the Clothes Closet served 3,177 families. This year, they may serve over 6,000 families. Three years ago, food was served to 5,631 people. Last year, 12,440 people received food, an increase of over 100%. Those numbers ought to both shock us and thrill us. We should be shocked that so many people in our area have an insecure food supply. We should be thrilled, though, that churches are banding together and meeting the basic needs of people.

Since the Collisons are eating pretty well these days, I have a new proposal for Island View Baptist Church: **LET'S POUND THE PANTRY.** Let's give to the hungry at least as generously as we give to one another. (My family had to borrow a truck to get all the food to our home. I'd love to take two trucks to the food pantry.)



We'll be observing communion together on **Sunday morning, August 8th**. What better time to share good gifts with others than when we receive God's good gifts together? Please bring your donations to the Narthex of the Sanctuary on that Sunday. You can also bring them to the church office during the week.

Some Benefits of Daily worship:

- * Daily worship gives God a time when we are focused on Him, to refresh us when we are hurting or walking through difficult times.

If you do not have a time scheduled for daily worship, I would encourage you to try it.
